

2. Draw notes with stems on the LINES shown by the numbers.

3. Draw notes with stems in the SPACES shown by the numbers.

A musical staff with a single note in the first space. Below the staff are the numbers: 1, 4, 3, 1, 2, 4, 2, 3, 1, 4.

There can be a note on every line and in every space on the staff. Like the keys on the keyboard these notes are named in the same order as the first seven letters of the alphabet A B C D E F G.

A CLEF is a sign that is put at the beginning of every staff to show exactly where one particular note is.

This is the TREBLE or G CLEF. It curls around line 2 to show you where the G above middle C is.



To draw a treble clef follow these five steps.
