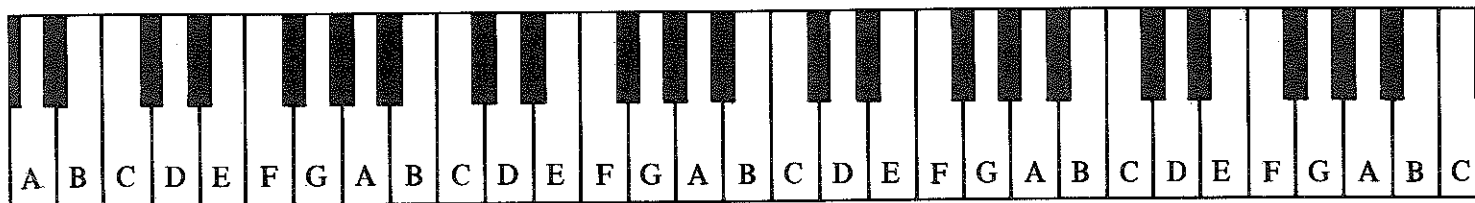
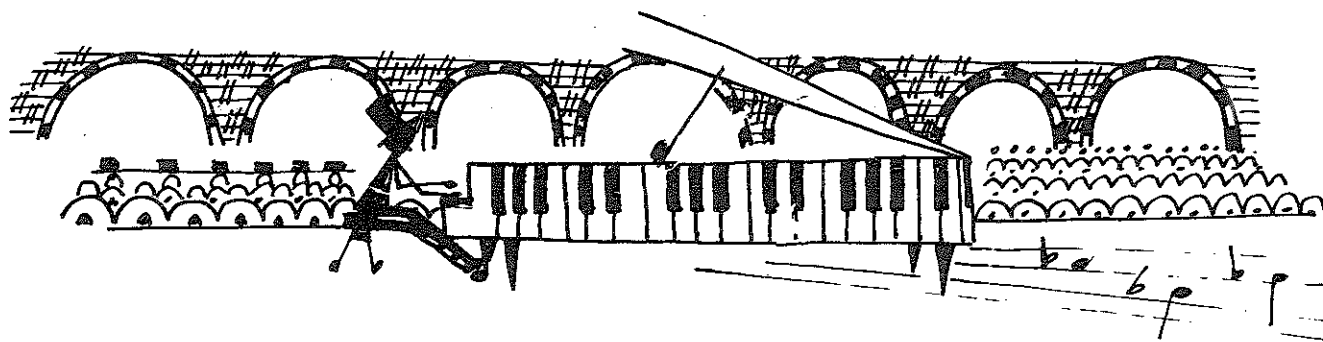


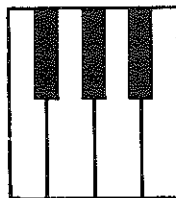
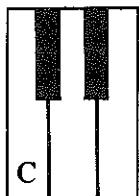
THE KEYBOARD



The piano keyboard has white keys and black keys.

The white keys have the same letter-names as the first seven letters of the alphabet — A B C D E F G. When we get to G we start all over again until we have named every key on the piano.

The black keys are arranged in groups of twos and threes.



Every key whose name is C is found just to the left of a group of two black keys.

The C nearest the middle of the piano is called Middle C.
